

Survey Results from 2006 Australian National Arabian Championships

The Board wrote to the 252 Exhibitors at the 2006 Championship and received responses from 95 Exhibitors, a response rate of 38%.

The survey results are summarised below. The responses generally were similar to last year's survey, with 85% of the respondents believing the show should rotate and 68% of respondents in favour of an open ring. The major concern with facilities related to the size and safety issues with stabling. The Board will take into account the survey results when considering the venue for 2008.
