1. Owners must have at least one other pre-nominated exhibit as per standard schedule entry requirements and such pre-nominated exhibit/s must be catalogued in the 2010 Show Programme.
2. Owners must provide a fully completed entry form in legible hand writing and attach a copy of the exhibit's current registration certificate, front and back, for the entry to be accepted on the day.
3. Payment of entry fee will only be accepted in CASH (No Exceptions.)
4. Entry fee will be double the pre-entry cost per exhibit per class.
5. Nominations will only be accepted until one (1) hour prior to the commencement of the Show on Saturday and Sunday.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All horses must be registered with the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd & a photocopy of the relevant registration papers (**front and back**) for each horse must accompany entries.
2. All entries **must** be made in writing on supplied forms & lodged with the Show Secretary on or before the closing date or postmarked with the closing date of entries. **LATE ENTRIES will attract an additional fee of \$5.00 (in addition to normal entry fees) per entry form per owner/exhibitor.**
3. The lodging of any entry shall bind the exhibitor/trainer/owner to the conditions set out herein & the signature of an exhibitor/trainer/owner shall be deemed acceptance of these said conditions.
4. **Conduct:** Any horses deemed to be loose or out of control, or are a danger to others, will be excused from the ring. **Excessive use of whips or chains or any other actions wherever on the showground observed by or deemed cruel by the Judge, Steward, Marshall or an Official of the Show will result in horse & handler, exhibitor, trainer, rider or driver being excused from the ring as well as forfeiting all prizes and or monies gained. Handlers/Trainers/Owners/Exhibitors are not to incite any horse to challenge by facing up to each other or overcrowding.**
5. The correct exhibit number must be clearly displayed on the handler/rider.
6. Birth date of all horses to be taken as August 1st.
7. Stallions & colts must be entire.
8. Geldings must be gelded. Foals registered as geldings cannot compete in the colt classes.
9. No responsibility will be taken for any loss or accident which may be caused by, or suffered by an exhibit or owner/exhibitor/person & it is a condition of entry that exhibitors/owners/persons shall hold the Show Committee indemnified against any claim in respect of any accident, loss or damage.

10. The Show Committee shall have the power without assigning any reason to:
 - (i) Cancel or reject any entry at any time.
 - (ii) Cancel any event or class, divide or combine classes in relation to entries received or transfer any exhibit from one class to another.
 - (iii) **Classes may be cancelled and/or combined at the discretion of the Show Committee if a minimum of 3 entries per class are not received.**
 - (iv) Remove any exhibit, handler, trainer, owner, exhibitor from the grounds.
 - (v) The judge's decision is final.
11. Any cheque received or accepted by the Show Committee shall be deemed to have been received as conditional payment only & subject to payment upon presentation.
12. (i) A **Maiden** is defined as not having won a first place at any show at the closing date of entry. All maiden horses **must** be ridden in a **snaffle bit**.
- (ii) A **Novice** is defined as not having won a first place in an **Open Hack Class** or **Championship (Novice or Open)** at any official show. To be ridden in a **snaffle bit** with or without a drop/□enalized□ noseband and/or cavesson. No Top Hats.
- (iii) A **Newcomer** is defined as a competitor who has not competed in any show and/or agricultural show prior to 1 August 2009 (Pan Pacific Arabian Assoc. Inc. rule.). Must be ridden in a **snaffle bit**.
- (iv) An **Intermediate Hack** is a Hack which has not won a first place at Intermediate or Open level or a Championship (Intermediate or Open) at an official show at closing date of entry.
- (v) **Open Hack** is a Hack which is able to perform at Maiden, Novice and Intermediate levels and as the Judge may direct. To be ridden in a double bridle or snaffle bit. Open saddle horses should not be penalised for showing in a snaffle bit.
13. **Broodmares** may enter either the broodmare class or their age class **but not both**. A broodmare is one which has had a foal at foot in the previous 12 months, is tested in foal (vet.certificate to be supplied) or has a foal at foot.
14. To be eligible for an award an exhibit must not exhibit lameness & must be under control at all times.
15. No stallion is to be handled or ridden by a person under 18 years of age.
16. **Handlers:** A handler shall show one (1) horse only in each heat and/or class. The handler in charge of an animal when it enters the judging ring will show that horse. Interchanging of handlers will not be permitted; one horse-one handler. If applicable, judging will not be delayed for handlers to change judging rings so it is advisable that back-up handlers be engaged. Handlers must adopt a reasonable standard of dress. No thongs, shorts etc.
17. **Exhibitors** are reminded that every reasonable effort will be made to maintain a functional public address system & make adequate class calls, **this service is a courtesy. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their horse in the marshalling area in the appropriate time. NO PROTEST ON THESE GROUNDS WILL BE ACKNOWLEDGED.**
18. Stabling preference will be given to long distance travellers camping over with stallions.
19. Performance Classes conducted under AHSA Limited rules and Pan Pacific rules.
20. **Youth** are to be **17 years and under** at the time of the Show.
21. **Youth Events: All youth riders must wear an approved Australian Safety Standards helmet in all events in which they compete. Approval No AS/NZ 3838 should be on your helmet. Check your helmet as it may be checked on the day for insurance purposes.**
 - (i) **YOUTH CLASSES.** Age Classes will be combined if a minimum of three (3) entries per class are not received.
 - (ii) **LEAD REIN CLASS** is for any rider under 8 yrs. Rider not eligible to compete in any other ridden class.
23. (i) **No entry fees will be refunded for any reason whatsoever. Entry fees will not be refunded to exhibitors rejected due to non-compliance with Conditions of Entry.**
- (ii) **Stabling/Camping Fees will only be refunded if written advice is received by the Show Secretary five (5) days prior to the Pan Pacific Arabian Show date.**
24. **Halter & Performance Classes:** Five (5) finalists will be selected from each class. First (1st) and Second (2nd) placegetters will be chosen at time of judging with remaining three placegetters comprising TOP 5.
25. **All 1st place and 2nd place winners are to present their horses in their respective Championship Classes.** If this rule is not adhered to, those horses not presented will forfeit their first place award which will not be necessarily awarded to the 2nd placegetter.
26. **Handlers/Exhibitors:** No handler/exhibitor shall adhere any foreign object to their whip or their person.
27. **Loose Exhibits:** Any horse which becomes loose and escapes from the handler/rider/driver in the judging arena for any reason may be excused from the class. If the horse remains in the immediate judging area out of lead reach and does not interfere with any other horse to cause danger or disturbance, is retrieved promptly by the handler/rider/driver, it may at the discretion of the ringmaster/chief steward continue to be judged.
28. (i) **Amateur Owner Handler/Rider:** A person is considered to be an Amateur Owner Handler/Rider under AHSA rules when the person has not accepted remuneration for riding, driving, showing in halter/in hand, training, schooling or conducting clinics or seminars or accepts remuneration for giving instructions in equitation or horse training or assisted in the training of a horse for remuneration.
- (ii) Must hold a current AHSA Amateur Owner Card and must attach a copy to the entry form..

29. **Pan for Gold Event:** See details in Performance Section of Schedule
30. **Youth Gold Nugget Award:** See details in Performance Section of Schedule.
31. **Any Protest** is to be lodged in writing with a fee of \$50 cash to the Show Secretary. If the complaint is not substantiated within ONE (1) HOUR upon receipt of the written protest, the monies will be forfeited. All disputes will be determined by the disputes committee, consisting of two (2) committee members, Chief Ring Steward and one (1) competitor.
32. **Rule Books. It is the responsibility of all competitors to ensure that they are conversant with current AHSA and HSAA Rules.**

33. Pan Pacific Arabian Association Inc. - Memberships:

- (i) If an exhibit is registered with the AHSA Ltd in an individual's name, the single membership fee of \$20.00 is applicable when accessing membership rates of entry fees to this event, otherwise;
- (ii) If an exhibit is registered with the AHSA Ltd in family name, joint names or stud name, the membership fee of \$25.00 is applicable when accessing membership rates of entry fees to this event.

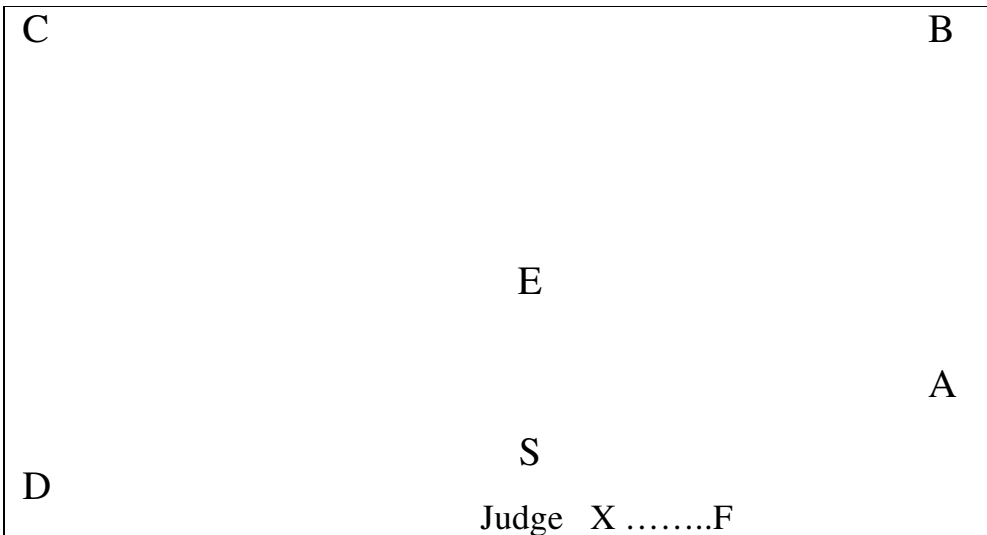

Walk to Judge and stand. Upon Judge's command:-Trot right on the circle (towards A to B)
 Lengthen Trot (from B to C) Halt 4 Secs
 Then Canter Left on the circle (towards D then to E)
 At E Change and Canter Full Circle right (to B to A to E)
 At E Extended Canter to the right (to B) then,
 Midway between B & A, trot on the circle towards A and progress to a Halt at X.
 Rein Back 4 Steps and Finish at F.

Horses will be judged at Halter and Handler Presentation will be taken into account. However the emphasis will be on Performance. Horses are to enter the ring individually in number order as per catalogue and as per halter class rules. They will present to the judge to be judged at Halter and then will be allowed to move to ringside where they can prepare for their individual performance. One strapper only will be allowed to assist the rider to saddle the horse. Horses are to enter the ring individually in catalogue number order for performance. Horses being judged are to be presented in English Manner, Plaited, English Style Saddle, Snaffle Bridle or Double Bridle accepted. Rider to be in English Attire, **no dressage whips, no Arabian Show Halters**, hacking canes and spurs optional.

Please note that if exhibits are entered in both the Youth Nugget and Pan for Gold Events, these exhibits will be judged out of numerical order and will be judged accordingly in their respective event.

Competitors will not be allowed to depart from the ring for any reason until judging is completed; to do so will incur automatic disqualification.

YOUTH CLASSES

If classes have less than three (3) entries, classes will be combined
i.e. (i) 11 yrs & under (ii) 12 yrs to 17 yrs at the discretion of the show committee.

RING ONE (2)

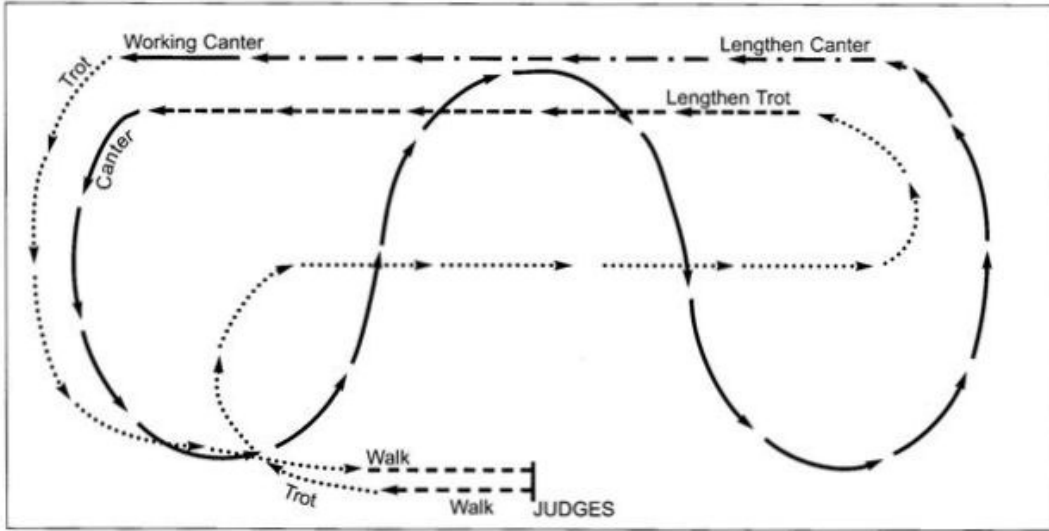
Although horses are being judged at halter, the emphasis will be on performance. Saddle marks will not be penalized. Rider to be in English Attire, **no dressage whips, no Arabian Show Halters**, hacking canes and spurs optional.

Competitors will enter Ring One (1) in numerical order and will be judged individually under saddle. On completion of their workout, will move to ringside where rider will dismount, unsaddle and prepare for the Halter Judge. **One strapper only** will be allowed to assist rider and collect saddle/gear.
