

ANNA STOJANOWSKA ~ POLAND

Anna Stojanowska is an Animal Sciences graduate from the Warsaw Agricultural University, Poland, specializing in Horse Breeding.

Between 1993 & 1995 Anna worked at Arabian State Studs in Poland including Michałów Stud, Kurozwęki Stud, Bialka Stud and Janów Podlaski Stud. In 1995 she was employed in the Agricultural Property Agency, who is the owner of the Arabian State Studs, as a horse breeding specialist and advisor to the State Studs. Anna still holds this position today.

In 1999, Anna completed and passed the International ECAHO Judges Course and went on to become an International Arabian horse judge.

Anna has judged Arabian shows in most European countries as well as the Middle East {Jordan, Qatar, Saudi Arabian & United Arab Emirates}. She judges an average of 7 – 10 shows per year.

Anna is a co-organiser of Arabian horse shows in Poland and is herself, a breeder of Arabian horses. She is also a member of the Executive Committee of the European Conference of Arabian Horse Organisations {ECAHO}.

Although Polish is Anna's native language, she is also fluent in English and Russian. She is very interested in the histories of horse breeding and the ecology and well being of all animals. Anna is also interested in dog breeding and loves the theatre.

When asked what her pet hates are, Anna responds that she hates to see fear of the handler from any horse. The welfare of the horse is paramount.
