

DO YOU WANT TO A.I. MARES USING TRANSPORTED CHILLED OR FROZEN SEMEN FROM A STALLION RESIDENT IN AUSTRALIA

1. Nominate the stallion for 'A.I. Use At Stud' using the appropriate form and order the required number of 'transported/stored semen' service certificates. (*note: these are not the normal breeding documents*)
2. Ensure that mares to be inseminated have been DNA typed **prior** to insemination and are nominated for use in an A.I. program (*note: if this has not been done the mare owners/lessees will not have the appropriate paperwork for completion when mares are inseminated*)
3. Complete the monthly 'transported semen' report at the end of each month in which semen has been transported detailing transportations and return to the Society **within 7 days**.
4. Forward the 'Transported/Stored Semen' Service Certificate to the mare owner when the service fee has been paid.
5. Complete the 'Stallion Return' at the end of the season listing all mares served or for whom semen has been supplied (*even if they have not gone in foal and the service fee has not been paid*).

REMINDER:

ALL ARABIAN COLTS AND FILLIES CONCEIVED BY A.I. USING SEMEN COLLECTED OR STORED IN AUSTRALIA REQUIRE SUCCESSFUL PARENTAGE VERIFICATION BY DNA TYPING PRIOR TO REGISTRATION.

NOTE: FAILURE TO SUBMIT THE ABOVE BREEDING DOCUMENTATION MAY RESULT IN THE STALLION BEING LISTED AS AN 'INELIGIBLE SIRE' IN THE ARABIAN HORSE NEWS OR THE REJECTION OF AN A.I. PERMIT FOR THE FOLLOWING BREEDING SEASON.
