Dear Members,

This is a wonderful time of the year with the foaling season coming upon us fast and the results and dreams of our breeding decisions last season come to fruition. As the weather warms up, regular shows and events will be in full swing with already strong feedback that these events will be strongly supported.

For those who are not aware, the AHSAR physical office is closed due to Covid 19 regulations. The most efficient way to get a return phone call is to email with your phone number and what your enquiry is about so it can be directed to the right person. Please also include the best time to call you back. Please be mindful that while we attempt to move forward without disruption, it's possible there may be some delays in fulfilling your request.

The Board and committees have continued to meet on a regular basis via Zoom which has proved an invaluable resource, allowing Board meetings to be held at very short notice and at virtually any time.

Australian Arabian National Championships

I'm excited to announce that the 40th Anniversary Australian Arabian Championships will be held at Sydney International Equestrian Centre, 9th - 13th March 2022. As mentioned previously, the Non Pro Championships and Youth Championships will be held in conjunction. See more information in the flyer at the end of this news.

Some of you may be aware of an Affiliation rule which states that no affiliate may run a show at the same venue within 4 weeks of the Australian Championships. This year the NSW AHA will be running the East Coast Championships on the weekend prior to the Australian Championships. NSW AHA have been advised they are in breach of the affiliation agreement, however due to extenuating circumstances the Board has discussed at length and approved the dates for 2022

We look forward to seeing everyone at the 'Aussies' in 2022!

Judges and Officials Committee

As previously advised the Board and JOC sought feedback from judges on how best to implement the reinstating of the National Panel as the benchmark for eligibility to judge internationally. The Board took this step following consistent messaging from judges about various personal or structural concerns relating to the International Panel.

I am pleased to advise that the Board and JOC received a very good response from judges with a wide variety of views and suggestions – some through email, submissions or as a petition. However, the majority of feedback received, including nine written submissions were clearly in favour of the Board proposal. In particular the Board's concern about providing a level playing field for all National Panel judges was a consistent theme.

The Board subsequently tasked the JOC to review all proposals put forward with a view to cherry picking the best ideas or opportunities. One of our aims of this process was to ensure that current international qualifications are duly recognised and that we also provide equal opportunities for all National Panel judges. I wanted to sincerely thank judges for the positive and constructive responses that we received.

Code of Conduct

In the spirit of continuing improvement and transparency, the Board has recently approved a new Code of Conduct for Board members which re-enforces our values and behaviours and compels each board member to be accountable for their behaviour.

Finance Committee

With declining memberships and registrations, the board is very mindful of our current unsustainable financial position.

The Finance Committee is happy to report that the Share Investments that we made in May already show a "Profit" of \$10,500 and we have received our first quarterly Dividend. As a matter of interest, had we made these same Investments in June 2020, the AHSA would presently be showing a "PROFIT" of approx. \$138,000. Investments continue to perform well and we will keep you abreast of developments.

Expenses are under scrutiny with any opportunity to reduce running expenses being considered. For example, recently Office expenses have been reduced by \$283 per month by introducing software changes relating to Office 365.

Advice regarding member disputes

A reminder that the AHSA Ltd will not become involved in, adjudicate or manage any agreements between members or withhold the registration or transfer of any eligible horse if the required AHSA Ltd documentation has been provided to the Society.

The Society's policy in relation to disputes associated with breeding or ownership of horses, agistment, payment of fees, personal or contractual agreements or disagreements between members is that these are civil matters and the AHSA will not become involved. Members are advised to seek legal advice if they are unable to resolve the situation and they are strongly advised to ensure that relevant contractual agreements regarding all transactions have been established.
