

Registrar / Office Managers Report 2023

The first half of 2022 saw the implementation of AHSA Ltd. Membership Renewals being handled and renewed via Nominat. This was a learning curve for office staff and members alike, with only a few minor hiccups. I am happy to report that these were all handled very efficiently between AHSA Ltd. and Nominat staff. Not only have we received reports from members as to how impressed they are with the ease of renewing via Nominat, but the new system means substantial time-saving within The AHSA Ltd. office as well. We are very pleased to be conducting renewals via Nominat again in late 2022 for 2023 with confidence.

The latter half of the year, saw major changes to staffing at The Arabian Horse Society Ltd Office, with longstanding Registrar Helen Dohan retiring in July, closely followed by longstanding registry clerk Lindy Stewart also retiring in September. With their 50 plus years of combined experience, The AHSA Ltd. office has indeed lost a vast amount of knowledge and experience. I would like to personally Thank, both Helen and Lindy for their diligence, hard work and loyalty to The Society and congratulate them both on their retirement.

This loss saw a reduction in staff from one full-time and three part-time to the current, three part-time employees and resulted in the employment of our newest staff member Kelly Anscombe as a registry clerk. Juliet Burnett was appointed as Assistant Registrar and I have been appointed as Registrar and Office Manager. I wish to thank The Board and The Members for their patience while we have been navigating our new roles and establishing new routines.

Along with the changes mentioned, my attendance at the 2022 WAHO Conference in October 2022, the extremely busy audit period in early 2023 and an earlier 2023 Australian Arabian National Championships, meant that the office was stretched quite thin over a long period of time. I would like to thank Juliet, who has been amazingly supportive in adapting to the changes and stepping up without question to assist me whilst I have been busy completing other tasks. Our newest team member Kelly also deserves much praise for not only learning our systems and processes, but also jumping in to assist the Events Committee before, during and after the show without any prior knowledge or experience. Our staff's efforts should not go unnoticed, and I commend them all on those effort, their loyalty and their commitment to The Society during 2022, particularly to Juliet and Kelly for these last six months.
